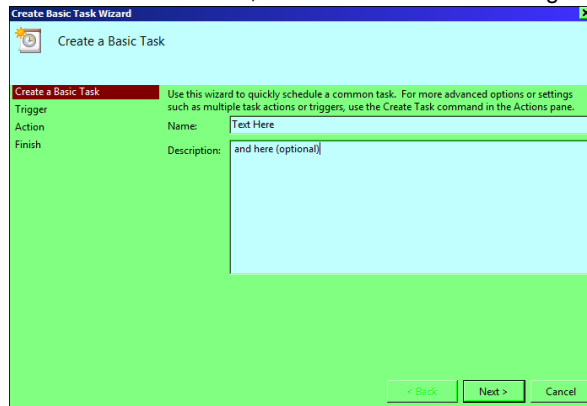
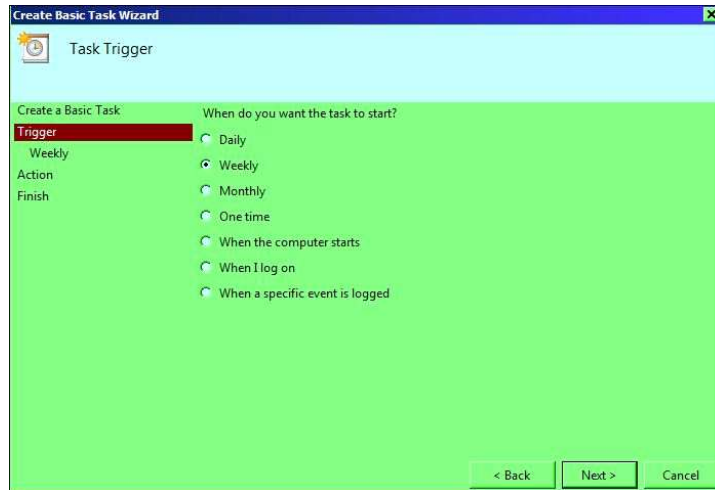


How to set Task Scheduler to Restart your PC.

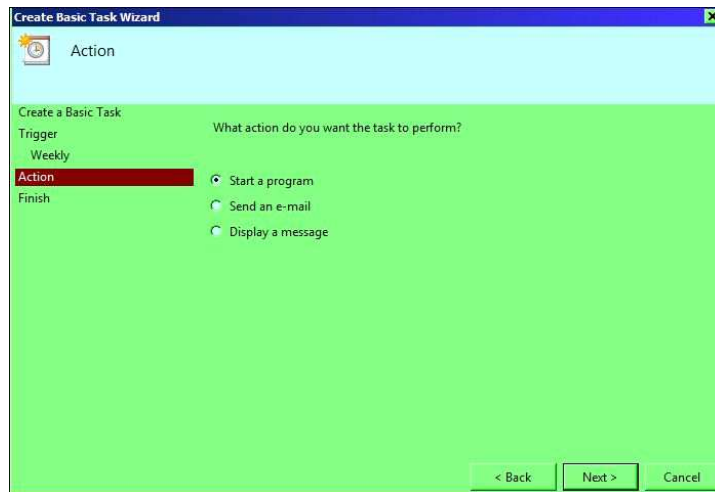
Open Task Scheduler and select, 'Create basic task' in the right hand pane.



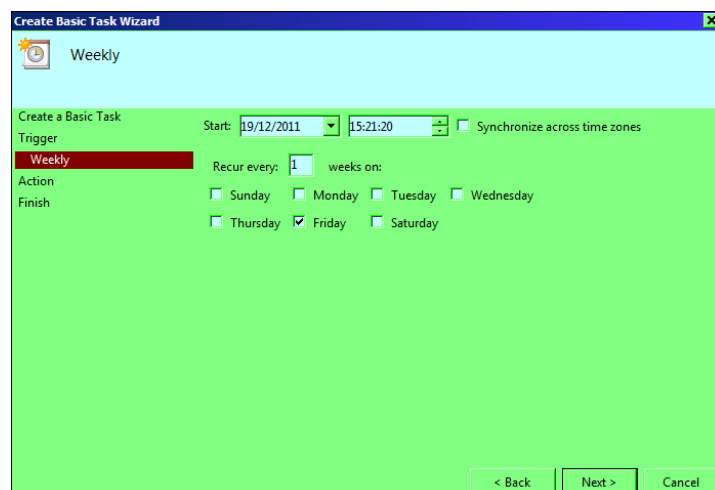
Type Restart in the Name box. Click next.




Select when you want it to run, click next.




